- **Clock Tent at Driving Range**

Response: Funding is not available to replace the yardage tags on the repaired sprinkler heads

- **Defined entry points to the fairway forward of the tee box**

Response: Proper adherence to the 90 degree rule would reduce the heavy traffic wear out in front of the tee boxes

- **Keeping carts on the cart paths near the greens and tees**

Response: All golfers are reminded that keeping All Four Wheels on the cart path will stop the wear out being created along the cart paths

- **Drinking water at the bag drop**

Response: Eddie Pratt will inform those responsible for this task
