

Greens Committee Notes

April 13, 2009

The Greens Committee has not had a formal meeting since November of 2008. The Sea Trail Staff has been unable to meet with the members because of their limited overall staffing. During this period they have been receptive to our questions and concerns. Following are some recent questions and concerns and Sea Trail Staff responses.

Question: When are the rangers coming back – there is a lot of abuse going on the courses.

Response from Eddie Pratt: I understand these concerns as they are ours also. However, due to the current state of the economy and budget constraints here at Sea Trail, Rangers may only be available to us on a very limited basis. For the moment, the starters and Cart Attendants (when not busy) are riding the courses to help patrol and monitor play.

Question: Are the out of bounds stakes going to change on hole 3 of the Maples when the house is completed? We need a more visible OB stake on Byrd 4 – last Charleston house.

Response from Matt Owens: I will check the placement of the OB stakes on 3 Maples and 4 Byrd and make adjustments as necessary.

Question: When will we get flat ladies tees?

Response from Matt Owens: There are several tee boxes around the property that are in need of an upgrade. The issue includes both men's and ladies' tees and is predominantly the result of age and wear and tear. When resources become available and a project of this magnitude becomes realistic, we will make all necessary corrections, at this time though we must devote all available resources to daily maintenance of the courses.

Question: Will Magnolias or Maples open for full hot breakfasts and lunches again?

Response from Eddie Pratt: The re-opening to Magnolias is also dependent on economic conditions. To my knowledge there has been no official re-opening date determined for Magnolias. Nonetheless, the Snack Bar at Magnolias is currently serving a mini buffet breakfast, and offers a limited lunch menu (highlighted by various burger choices) with the grill now open until 2:30pm. Although Brassies at the Maples does not provide the mini buffet breakfast, they do offer the same limited lunch menu until 2:30pm.

The members of the greens committee still look for input relating to questions and concerns from the members. Eddie Pratt Dir. of Golf and Matt Owens Dir. Golf Maintenance have been quick to respond to our concerns.
