

STMGA HOLE-IN-ONE POLICY

Updated February 1, 2008

1. A STMGA member recording a hole-in-one during any STMGA sponsored eighteen hole round will have his achievement recognized by the presentation of a suitable award and by having his name engraved on the existing STMGA Hole-In-One plaque.
2. A STMGA member recording a hole-in-one during a non-STMGA sponsored eighteen hole round on any of the Sea Trail courses will have his achievement recognized by the presentation of a suitable certificate and by having his name engraved on the existing STMGA Hole-In-One plaque.
3. A STMGA member recording a hole-in-one during an eighteen hole round on a non-Sea Trail course will have his achievement recognized only by the presentation of a suitable certificate.
4. In all cases the hole-in-one should be witnessed by other golfers and the member's score for the round must be entered into the STMGA handicap system for official handicap purposes.

Hole-In-One Beverage Policy (Sea Trail Courses Only)

1. The member having the hole-in-one should report it to the pro shop and the bartender at the clubhouse of the Sea Trail golf course involved.
2. One free drink will be allowed for each STMGA member and their guests, if applicable, participating in the STMGA golf event that day.
3. One free drink will also be allowed for those STMGA members who are present if a member gets a hole-in-one on a Sea Trail course during a non-STMGA event.
4. The free drink shall be domestic beer, house wine or house liquor.
5. The STMGA member having the hole-in-one is responsible for ensuring that only persons eligible under this policy consume a free drink.
6. The STMGA celebrant is responsible for reviewing and signing the bar bill. The celebrant will either add up to a twenty percent (20%) gratuity to the bar tab or request that the Sea Trail bartender have Sea Trail add their standard eighteen percent (18%) gratuity to the bar tab when Sea Trail invoices STMGA for the total bill. STMGA will only pay for one gratuity. A copy of the charge receipt which clearly reflects your name should then be placed in the STMGA lock box located in the computer room at the Jones/Byrd clubhouse or given to the Treasurer.
